Prayer:

This verse solidifies joy and fulfillment in our relationship with God, making Him our priority and source of delight. When we <u>align our desires</u> with His will and place our trust in Him, He responds by guiding our paths and bringing His

purposes to fruition in our lives. It's a reminder that true fulfillment comes from seeking God first and letting Him shape our dreams and actions.







Prayer:

True, lasting change doesn't come solely from our own efforts; it comes from allowing God to work within us. It's about surrendering our old ways and letting Him renew us from the inside outa changed life, this transformation means moving away from a life that may be self-centered, indifferent, or resistant to positive growth. With Godfidence, we have courage and peace knowing that God is in control, and we can trust His

plan for our lives.







Prayer:

Create Boundaries Matthew 5:37 All you need to say is simply 'Yes' or 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one



Prayer:

Line In The Sand Joshya 24:15

But if serving the Lord seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord."

"line in the sand" typically.refers to a point of no return or a boundary that should not be crossed. It often implies a decision or stance that, once taken, will lead to significant consequences. It can be used in various contexts, from personal relationships to political situations. This idea reflects the struggle between temptation and the commitment to doing what is right which encourages focusing on the path ahead and not swaying from it. It emphasizes the importance of making wise choices and maintaining integrity.

REMEMBER THIS: Proverbs 4:25-27





Prayer:

The Foundation Mathew 7:24-25

"Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. 25 The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock.

Prayer:

Prayer:

Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven








Prayer:

Reframing emotions often involves seeing situations from a different perspective. Even in tough situations, God is working f.or our good, helping us to reframe our perspective on hardships

Prayer:

New Thing Isaiah 43:18-19 Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. See, I am doing a new thing. Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland . Opportunity for renewal and growth is always beofre us.

Let go of past experiences and be open to the new things God is bringing into our lives.
